Medieval Knights and Kingdoms is going to be an exciting class this semester! Your student will explore the life and times of the Middle Ages through an interactive, hands-on approach that will make this historic era come alive! The class will focus on the region of Europe as they discover various facts about the feudal system, the monarchs and the duties of knights, medieval customs, family traditions, traditional foods, music, art, and literature. Students will have fun designing kingdoms, castles, shields, and swords! Each week, we will open our class session with the “Medieval F.L.A.P. 5” (“Fact about Life And/or People in 5 minutes”) game. Weekly, each student is encouraged to bring in to class a hand-written fact about life or a person who lived during the Middle Ages. When the student shares this fact with the class, he or she earns a trip to the famous “Treasure Box”!

Through numerous classroom activities and games, your child will understand concepts that are associated with the Middle Ages. This period is rich in the history of our faith—the hand of God is evident in recorded events and accounts of people’s lives!

There is a list of supplies needed to enrich the learning activities of the class. Please assist me by encouraging your child to bring these supplies to class each week as this enhances their confidence and success.
