If you already have something that will work and safely transport glass, that is fine. You will need to purchase glass nippers for class. You can get them at Hobby Lobby using their 40% off coupon and paying approx. \$15.00. You can also purchase them at Kingwood Glass Company, just off of Ford Rd. Be sure to purchase the nippers that have the small wheels on the top. Please mark your nippers so that you can keep track of which pair is yours!
