Super Friday Policies

STANDARDS OF EXCELLENCE: In order to create an atmosphere of excellence and glorify our Lord and Savior, the following standards will need to be followed by the students and supported by their parents. The behavior, language, dress, and study habits of each student should reflect obedience to the Bible and the standards outlined below.

- **DRESS CODE** - Students will dress in modest and neat attire. Shorts and skirts must be longer than tip of fingers when measured with arms straight to your side. Shorts must be worn under skirts. Tank tops, bare feet, "in-style" ripped clothing, HATS, and T-shirts with inappropriate messages are also prohibited. It is desired that clothing will present a Christian testimony.
- **CELL PHONES** — In order to promote an atmosphere of undistracted learning, we require that cell phones be turned off and kept in a backpack or pocket. If you need to call your child, please use the office number of 281-360-4910. If your child needs to contact you please instruct them to come to office to place their call. **Texting is not allowed at Super Friday.** If your child has his cell phone out during Super Friday hours of 8:45-12:15 it will be taken and held by a Staff Member and returned to you, the parent, at dismissal.
- **CLASSROOM CONDUCT** - Please arrive by 8:45 for opening assembly. Tardiness is disrespectful and disrupts the activities. We require respectful behavior in the classroom toward both the teacher and fellow students. Note passing, talking in class, and inattentiveness are distracting to others and prevent the teacher from completing the lesson in the allotted time. Please come prepared for each class with an "eager-to-learn" attitude. All students will assist in keeping the classrooms, hallways, kitchen, and outdoors clean and neat. **IPODS, games, phones and other personal belongings must be left at home.**

Super Friday Policies Continued

- **CHARACTER TRAINING**— The training of home schooled students to be role models and leaders in society is a goal we share with parents. Students should strive for excellence in their character by pursuing Godly characteristics, including, but certainly not limited to: kindness, a Christ—like love for others, obedience, responsibility, integrity, respect, attentiveness, gratefulness, and truthfulness.
- **DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES**—At the time of a student's first offense of any conduct codes, the student will be sent to the Director or Assistant Director. The student will be informed individually of expected changes in behavior, sign the discipline notebook and call a parent. If a second offense should occur, the student will be suspended for one class period, and call a parent. Any subsequent offenses will result in the removal of the child from the program.
- **ATTITUDE** - Great students will approach their learning and studying with eagerness and obedience. When a student has an attitude of respect for the teachers and classmates, all achieve excellence. Students will be best when aspiring to do their best! We strive to assist students in reaching their God-given potentials while emphasizing Christian values with enrichment and fun.

- **SIGN IN**—For the safety of our students, all outside doors will be locked at 9:00 AM. If you need to come into the building, we ask that you please sign in.
- **SNACKS**— During snack time we will have a variety of healthy snacks available for students to purchase for fifty cents a piece. Your child may also bring a snack from home. We will not allow charges.
- **ARRIVAL TIME**—Arrival time should be no earlier than 8:40. **MMO & Freshman will go directly to their rooms and Soph.—Sr. will go to the gym.**
- **DISMISSAL TIME**—Pick up time is 12:15. If it is later than 12:25, your child will need to be signed out and picked up from the Super Friday Office.
- **DISMISSAL**— All students will be lined up in the gymnasium at the end of the day. You will need to have an 8 1/2" x 11" card with your last name written in large print. You may either wait in the car line, or you may walk up to the side entrance and into the gym to pick up your child. You will be responsible for the safety of your child.
- **FACILITIES**—Students will respect the property of the facility. Defaced or broken property is to be replaced at the student's expense. Students will demonstrate care and respect to honor the graciousness of the church staff and members. Students may not roam the facility or grounds unsupervised.
