Arrivals and Dismissals

Older students (ages 7-14) can arrive as early as 8:30 and should go directly to the gymnasium for morning assembly, which begins at 8:45. Early Childhood students (ages 2-6) should be dropped off by a parent or guardian directly to their assigned classroom **no earlier** than 8:40. Dismissal line begins at 12:00 for EC and 12:15 for OC. If you are running late, please text (225-324-7758) and let me know. Parents arriving after 12:30 for pickup may be charged.

Snacks

Elementary and Junior High students have snack time from 11-11:20 in the gym. Concessions will be sold for \$1 each or students may bring **NUT-FREE** snacks from home. All students should bring their own water bottle. Early Childhood students should bring a nut-free snack and water bottle from home to have in class.

Character Training

We share with parents in the goal of training our homeschooled students to be role models and leaders in our community and in the world. Students should strive for excellence in their character by pursuing Godly characteristics including kindness, Christ-like love for others, obedience, responsibility, integrity, respect, thankfulness and truthfulness.

Facilities

Students will respect the property of the facility. Defaced or damaged property is to be replaced at the student's expense. Students will honor the graciousness of the church staff and members. Students are not allowed to roam the grounds or buildings unsupervised at any time.

Dress Code

Students will dress in modest and neat attire. Shorts and skirts must be longer than the tip of fingers when measured with arms straight down. Shorts must be worn under skirts. T-shirts or other clothing with inappropriate messages are prohibited. It is our desire that all students' appearance will present a Christian testimony.

Conduct and Attitude

We require respectful behavior in the classroom towards the teachers, staff, and fellow students. Note passing, talking out of turn in class and other disruptive behaviors are not allowed. **IPADS, cell phones, laptops and other internet-capable devices must be left at home or kept turned off in the student's bag, or they will be taken and returned to the parent. Please see the separate document addressing our technology policy.** Students should always be prepared for class with all needed supplies and with an attitude of respect for others and eagerness to learn. Students and staff alike should strive to glorify God in their thoughts, words and actions.

Discipline Procedures

At the time of a student's first offense of any conduct code, the student will be sent to the Director. The student will be counseled of expected changes in behavior and their parent will be called. If a second offense occurs, the student will be suspended for one class period and their parent will be called. At this time, a behavior plan may be made to help students succeed. Any subsequent offenses may result in the removal of the child from the program.

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
