For all classes, the student will be expected to bring each of these items AND whatever books and assignments have been requested to each class meeting. Your being properly prepared for class is reflected in your class participation grade. During the school year, the teachers may request other supplies as necessary.

**U.S. History and Fundamentals of English - Byrd**

- 3 Ring Binder
- 5 Divider Tabs
- Loose Leaf Paper
- Pens/Pencils
- Colored Pencils (History only)
- Highlighters (green, red, yellow)(English only)
- Blue, black and red pens (For English only)

**HS English 1 & 2 – Carman**

- 3-ring binder: 1 1/2-2 inch
- Loose-leaf style notebook paper (college or wide ruled) or wireless composition books which are perforated so that sheets of notebook paper tear out without leaving shredded paper along the edges (NO paper from a spiral)
- 10 pocketed folders with 3-ring binder holes: these will be placed in the 3-ring binder to be used for Grammar, Vocabulary, Writing, and the books we will be reading and studying as unit studies. \*\*Only 8 pocketed folders are needed for the Fundamentals of English class.
- Colored pens (2-3 of each color): black, blue, red

### **Intermediate English 1&2 and HS English 3&4 – Jackson**

- Pens: black, blue, and red
- Highlighters (green, blue, and yellow)
- 3-ring binder, 1 ½ —2-inch size, with loose-leaf notebook paper
- 6 or more sectional dividers (Intermediate English only)

### **Physics– Kossa**

- Mead Composition Notebook (100+ pages)
- Pencils and highlighters
- Glue stick and Scissors
- Graph paper
- College ruled notebook paper
- Binder -- 1 inch with five sectional dividers
- 12" ruler (with both inches and cm)

- Graphing calculator (TI-84 or higher recommended)

### **Economics and Government – Lawrence**

- 3-ring notebook with filler paper for class notes and handouts. NOTE: Spiral notebooks are fine for note taking. However, I will not accept papers turned in for homework which have been torn out of spiral binders.
- Pens and pencils
- Computer with Internet access at home
- CLASS PROJECTS will require additional supplies – to be determined largely by the student

### **Geography – Lawrence**

- Colored pencils (12-24 pack) and markers
- The ability to prepare and bring recipes/food items on occasion.
- Suggested items to purchase and keep at home are a World Atlas and a globe (for Geography)
- Handouts will be given in class. Students will be required to keep these handouts in appropriate folders in a 3-ring binder throughout the school year.
