

Super Friday Technology Policy

- Students are not allowed to use internet-capable tablets, laptops or phones at Super Fridays, unless they are required to use it for a class. This includes morning time before classes, snack time, and any time waiting on campus after classes, unless they are being supervised by a parent. Devices MUST remain in the student's bag and turned off at all times when not being used for a class.
- Students using a laptop or phone with internet access for a class (for example, programming, etc) are NOT allowed to open any website or app other than the ones directed by the teacher.
- Any student violating these rules will receive consequences as follows:
 - 1st offense- Student sent to Mrs. Pruyn, parents called, device confiscated until parent picks it up at the end of the day.
 - 2nd offense- Student sent to Mrs. Pruyn, parent called, device confiscated until parent picks it up at the end of the day, 1 week suspension from Super Fridays.
 - 3rd offense- Student will not be able to return to Super Fridays for the remainder of the semester.
