Arrivals and Dismissals

All STAFF FAMILIES, MDO FAMILIES AND PRIMARY FAMILIES may enter at the Nursery and Children's Entrance.

Primary Program students (ages 6-7) should be checked in by a parent or guardian and then go directly to their classroom **no earlier** than 8:40.


Mother's Day Out students (ages 1-5) should be checked in by a parent or guardian and then brought directly to their classroom **no earlier** than 8:40.

CLASSIC FAMILIES AND TEEN FAMILIES SHOULD ENTER at Worship Center Entrance.

Classic and Teen Program students (ages 7-16) can arrive as early as 8:30 and should check in and go directly to the Auditorium for morning assembly, which begins at 8:45.

We will have one dismissal line begins at 12:15 for all students. Each family will be assigned a Carline # to be put in the front windshield. If you are running late, please text Mrs. Dawn Pruyn (225-324-7758) and let her know. Parents arriving after 12:30 for pickup may be charged \$5 per minute.

Snacks

Conduct and Attitude

We require respectful behavior in the classroom towards the teachers, staff, and fellow students. Note passing, talking out of turn in class and other disruptive behaviors are not allowed. IPADS, cell phones, laptops and other internet-capable devices must be left at home or kept turned off in the student's bag (unless they are being used under teacher supervision for a class) or they will be taken and returned to the parent. Students should always be prepared for class with all needed supplies and with an attitude of respect for others and eagerness to learn. Students and staff alike should strive to glorify God in their thoughts, words and actions.
